La Ventana, located in Baja California Sur, is a destination that has gained popularity in recent years, not only for its natural beauty and its reputation as one of the best places in the world for kitesurfing, but also for its rich marine life. During the months of March to June, the crystal-clear waters of the Sea of Cortez are visited by large schools of mobula rays, which in turn attract orcas that come to hunt and feed on them.

Every year, the presence of orcas in La Ventana is becoming more frequent and it is an impressive spectacle for visitors. Watching these animals swim in the crystal-clear waters and hunt in their natural habitat is an experience that is never forgotten.

But the magic of this place doesn't end here, as these waters are also a transit point for incredible species such as whales, sperm whales, dolphins, and countless marine species. That's why this amazing place is becoming a more recognized destination for nature lovers and adventurous travelers looking to experience unique and close encounters with nature.





THE EXPEDITION



During the 5 days of the activity, we will meet at 8:00 am at the dock located in front of the "Playa Central" building.

Each day we will navigate for approximately 6 hours on our panga boats actively searching for all the marine life that the ocean has to offer and seeking that magical encounter that will remain in our memories forever.

Get ready to swim with huge schools of mobula rays, snorkel with dolphins, and whales.

With a bit of luck, you will enjoy an unforgettable day!

On the boat, we will have snacks, water, and a delicious local meal on board.


The possibility of seeing orcas on a trip is quite high, however, we cannot guarantee their appearance as they are wild animals that do not have a fixed location and are constantly on the move, so it is not always possible to see them.

Nevertheless, encounters with them are becoming more common in this area, and during a 5-day activity, the chances increase exponentially.

If we do see the orcas, we can swim with them and marvel at their majesty, but it is important to remember that sometimes it may be necessary to perform several "dives" before they relax and come to investigate closer.

In addition to orcas and schools of mobula rays, we are likely to see large pods of dolphins, whales, and even whale sharks.
