DAY 1: TRANSPORTATION FROM CABO OR LA PAZ


The adventure is about to begin. We will pick you up at the appointed time in the morning, either in Cabo or La Paz, to start the trip to a magical place far away from civilization, hidden in the peninsula of Baja California Sur, Magdalena Bay.

This wild destination is known for its huge ecological importance given the large number of terrestrial and marine species that reside there, and therefore has become a destination frequently visited by professional photographers and explorers of major producers, such as National Geographic, the BBC or Discovery Channel, among others.

The bay is a five and a half hour drive from San Jose del Cabo Airport and three hours from La Paz Airport, on the Pacific Ocean side.

We will arrive at the chosen hotel at sunset, with enough time to relax, unpack, receive the briefing of the activity for the next few days, and have dinner at the hotel's restaurant.

We recommend going to bed early, as you will have to get up early the next day.



DAY 2: MARLIN RUN AND GLAMPING

We will wake up early in the morning for breakfast at the hotel, and at 6:00 a.m. we will set sail to enjoy one of the most spectacular underwater events in the world.

We will sail several miles offshore in the Pacific Ocean to see the huge bait balls of sardines that feed marlins, sea lions, birds and many more species. We will spend the whole day snorkeling to enjoy this unique and exclusive underwater spectacle that will delight the most demanding and adventurous travelers. We will search not only for sardine bait balls, but also for humpback whales, dolphins, mobula rays, killer whales and an endless number of marine life that seasonally come to this underwater spectacle. In this activity everything is possible!

In mid-afternoon, we will move to our accommodation for the next two nights, an exclusive glamping on the deserted Magdalena Island. There we can enjoy exploring the island, kayaking or paddle surfing in the waters of the bay, or relaxing in front of the beach in a unique environment.

Finally, we will enjoy an a la carte dinner with the freshest and most delicious products of the region.




DAY 3: MARLIN RUN AND GLAMPING

We will return to look for sardine bait balls, marlins, humpback whales, dolphins, mobula rays, sharks and everything that the wild Pacific Ocean wants to gift us, until we end up completely exhausted.

We will have lunch on the boat and, once the activity is finished with the group satisfied, we will return to the camp to pick up all our luggage and we will start our way to the port of San Carlos.

There our transportation will be waiting for us to take us back to Cabo or La Paz after this incredible adventure.
